EARLY MINERS WERE NOT ALLOWED TO ORGANIZE ON COMPANY PROPERTY, SO STRIKING MINERS MET AT THE "UNION STUMP".

Black Diamond began as a coal mining town in the early 1880's, and incorporated as a city in 1959; Visit the BD Museum to learn more.

The Black Diamond Space Agreement set aside 1100 acres of forest land that will always be reserved for habitat and recreation.

The Green River Coal beds were the result of vegetative matter laid down 50 million years ago in Eocene swamps.

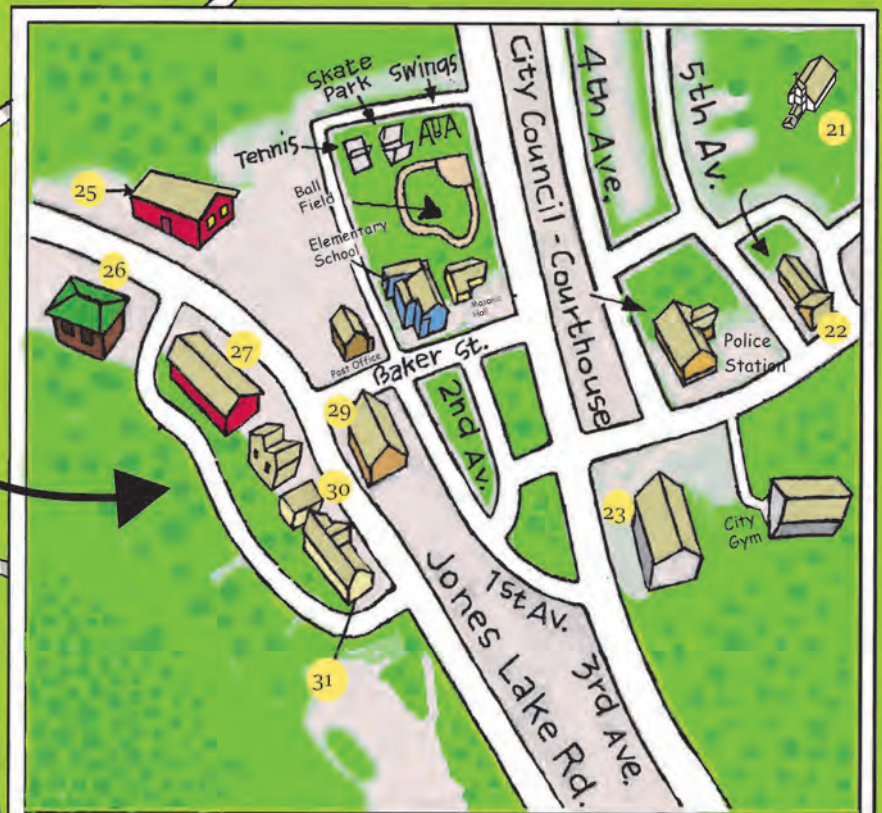
